IV. HCNC PROJECT STATUS SUMMARY

- Funding approval from WCB and scheduled approval from CCC on June 5h. Both Bachofer and Watson properties should close by July 3rd.
- CalTrans will need 10K for feasibility study of a new entry from Hwy 255 unless county takes responsibility for the road
- Initial public access is moving forward with directional signs on the road, and a trailhead sign
- Larry and Mike would like to see a sign specifically outlining rules and regulations, including hours of operation
- Restoration Plan close to complete
